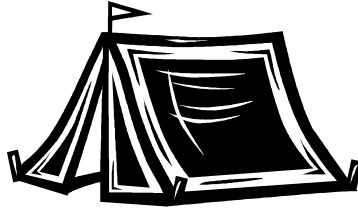


Kelso Camping Areas – Reserved Sites



Campsite 001

- Site Capacity 30-75
- Reservable site - \$175 per day includes HST
- Covers 18 campers per night @ \$10 per camper
- Located at the far west end of the park close to the beach
- Large trees provide lots of shade
- Near the west concession building that has flush toilets
- Vault toilets between sites A & B
- Access to water and hydro at west washroom

Note: *This campsite does not get booked for camping during prime time summer months- – July and August when sites are used by Day Camps.*

Campsite 002

- Site Capacity 30-75
- Reservable site - \$175 per day includes HST
- Covers 18 campers per night @ \$10 per camper or may be used as a picnic site @ 150 per day.
- Located at the far end of the park close to the beach staircase
- Large trees provide lots of shade
- Behind the west washroom (flush toilets and running water)
- Access to water and hydro at west washroom (one 15 amp outlet)
- Vault toilets between sites A & B

Note: *This campsite may be used as a campsite or picnic site however, this site does not get booked during prime time summer months - July and August when sites are used by Day Camps.*

The west end of the Park can become extremely busy with parking and foot traffic therefore sites 001 & 002 are not usually reservable during the months of July and August. During these months, these two sites are usually used on a “first come, first served” basis on the weekends.

Campsites 101 to 112 (Upper campsites)

- Site Capacity Max. 20
- Reservable site - \$50 per night includes HST
- Covers five campers @ \$10 per camper per night
- Located in the east end of the park, upper area across from the Agricultural Museum
- Long, flat, open sites
- Trees divide each site
- Vault toilets close in proximity to all sites (across from sites 104 & 112)
- Water pump (town water) beside site 101, between 107 & 109 and across from site 112

Campsites 301 to 304 (Lower campsites)

- Site Capacity 20-50
- Reservable sites - \$115 per night includes HST
- Covers 12 campers @ \$10 per camper per night
- Largest campsites within the park
- Great location for larger/corporate groups
- A line of trees divides each site
- Located in the east end of the park (lower area often referred to as "the flats")
- Fire pits are provided
- Water pump between sites 301 to 304
- Upgraded vault toilets between 302,303 & 304
- Close proximity to vault toilets and flush toilets/running water/showers in picnic site H (comfort station)
- River runs close by

Note: *These campsites tend to get flooded from the winter season, which in turn takes time to dry out. Therefore, these lower campsites are not always available for booking until mid to end of June.*

Campsite 305

- Site Capacity Max. 20
- Reservable site - \$50 per night includes HST
- Covers five campers @ \$10 per camper per night
- Smaller area compared to sites C-F
- Very shaded area
- Close to river
- Close proximity to vault toilets and flush toilets/running water/showers in site 8

Campsites 306 & 307

- Site Capacity Max. 20
- Reservable sites - \$50 per night includes HST
- Covers five campers @ \$10 per camper per night
- Large trees along perimeter of site for shade
- Close to flush washrooms/running water/showers in picnic site H and vault toilets in site 304

Campsite 308

- Site Capacity Max. 20
- Reservable site - \$50 per night includes HST
- Covers five campers @ \$10 per camper per night
- Secluded campsite & area
- Morning and evening shade
- Backs onto small unused, unmarked looped trail
- Close proximity to vault toilets in sites 302 & 303
