Established in 1958 by Barrick Gold, the Kelso Limestone Quarry spans 72 hectares of land. Aggregate from the quarry assisted in major local projects like the construction of the 401 and Pearson

International Airport. Conservation Halton became a restoration partner in 1995, and with official rehabilitation conditions met in 2006, the land was donated for future park use.



Conservation Halton has big plans for its newest park. The existing warehouse will be restored to serve as an indoor space for educational programs and events. With passive and active outdoor

recreation opportunities, our new park will nourish the body and help inspire the next generation of healthy outdoor enthusiasts. The sand beach surrounding the beautiful turquoise lake will be fully accessible, with opportunities for boating, playing, and lounging.

Environmental Trail Ethics

Trails are routed to protect neighbouring environmentally sensitive areas. Trail routes are selected to mitigate damage to animal and plant species. Poison Ivy may be found in some areas. Stay on trails to reduce risk of contact.

Dogs must be on a 2 metre leash at all times.
