## Appleby Line Reconstruction

### Location

Appleby Line from 80 m north of entrance to 7145 Appleby Line to 160 m south of entrance to 7145 Appleby Line

### Project Description

This project involves widening and reconstruction of the hairpin curve to permit improved traffic operations through the curve.

#### Enhancements include:

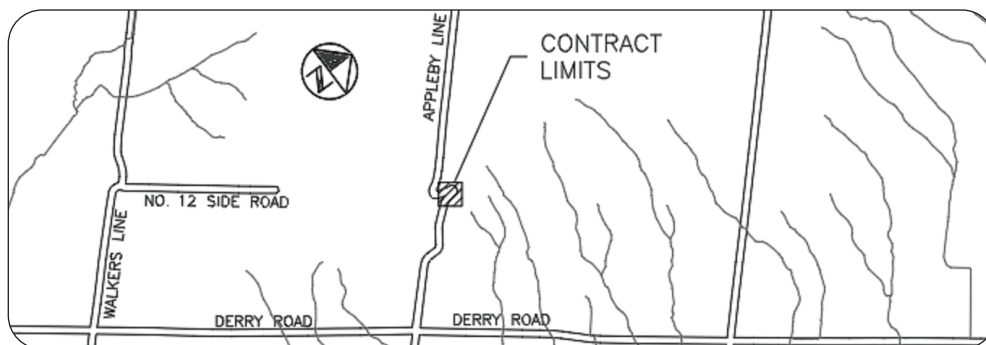
- For 2024, final paving and miscellaneous work will be completed

### Road Closures

Appleby Line will be closed to through traffic June-July 2024. Local access will be maintained.

Detour route traffic will be detoured via Derry Road, Bell School Line and 14 Side Road.
